REVISION IN SPECIALIST INSTRUCTOR'S COURSE

Medical Board at its meeting held on June 2, 2024 approved revision in Specialist Instructors' Course as under.

1. Eligibility:

- Basic First Aid certificate course of 16 sessions 2 hours each, including a written and a practical examination, conducted by the college.

2. Changes in the Examination pattern

a. proportions of Theory and Practical –

- Present: Written Paper 200 marks, Viva 35 marks, Practical Procedure 45 marks and Practical of Teaching 20 marks.

- In future Written paper and Viva 150 marks. Practical procedures 100 marks and Practical of Teaching 50 marks (Total 300 marks).

- Question Paper style – Instead of all questions to be answered, answer any 6 questions out of 8.

- Passing standards: Passing requirements 70%.

- Conducting the course and examination: When qualified student body is formed or declared by the commandant of the college once a year.

- Syllabus: a. Basic Anatomy (10 hours) b. Method of teaching (3 hours) c. Practice of teaching (3 hours) and (d) Syllabus of the Basic course of 14 sessions.

Requirements: All participants of FIRST AID course must have:

1. Triangular bandage: Take a Square Meter cloth and cut it diagonally to get two triangular bandages.
2. First aid Box : Contents;
 - a. Bottle of Dettol Solution: 1 part Dettol and 20 parts of water/Savlon)
 - b. Surgical cotton
 - c. Gauze pieces
 - d. Antiseptic cream
 - e. 2" Roller Bandages 6 Nos.
 - f. A pair of Scissors
 - g. One forceps

AN APPEAL FOR DONATION
